

Go approx. 1.5 miles when road bears right and becomes MIDDLE Road. Go another <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mile and turn LEFT onto LAKE St. Go 1 mile to Stop. Turn RIGHT onto MAIN St. Church is <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mile up on right.

**From Route 495**: Take Exit 5 (Route 18-South); Rt. 18 (Bedford St) merges on Rt. 105 south. Continue on Rt. 105 into Acushnet. Church is on the right. (#1215 Main Street).
